

This week in Caterpillars Class

For Mathematics this week we built a marble run, we counted out how many marbles we used, we worked on counting beyond 10. The marbles also helped us to improve our fine motor skills, picking them up and placing them at the top of the run.

We acted out 'The Tiger Who Came to Tea' for literacy.

In our role play area this week, we had Caterpillars Baby Clinic, we used tape measures to see how long the babies were, we bathed them and changed their nappies.

We also set up 'Caterpillars Cutz' hairdressing salon and 'Caterpillars Flower Pot' florists, we drew and labelled the different parts of a flower.

Next Week in Caterpillars Class

In our role play area next week we will have Caterpillars Doctors Surgery.

We will be building dens and practising yoga movements.

For Literacy, we will look at letters and write simple words, we will write Christmas cards to our friends.

On Wednesday we will start to open our Advent calendar and talk about what is in the box of the day, using our describing words.

This week in Ladybirds Class.....

We read the book 'Dear Zoo' we named the different animals in the book and we also made the different sounds the animals make.

We practised our motor skills, threading with pasta, we also had fun tipping and pouring Orbeez into water.

For communication and language we set up a tent and talked about inside/ outside, we used torches inside the tent and talked about on/off.

Our roleplay area was set up as a vets, were we washed the farm animals that were very muddy.

In the malleable area we made cakes with sand.

We will be using the marble run to help us with our counting numbers up to 10 and matching numbers to quantity

In our role play area we will have Caterpillars Post Office and Caterpillars Tadworth Train Station.

For Literacy we will look at 'The Gingerbread Man' and repeat refrain "Run, run as fast as you can....."
