

This week in Caterpillars Class

In our role play area we had our Caterpillars Cuppa's café where we made tea, coffee and sandwiches.

This week we made lots of different foods including, biscuit cheesecakes, there was a lot of stirring and pouring of liquids as well as spreading of butter and jam on the bread. We also made vegetable soup, cutting up the different vegetables and using ladles to stir.

For Maths we counted, using real money, as well as looked at the numbers on the different coins.

We matched sounds of letters to their objects, we learnt the letters M, S, J, using phonic games and sand play for literacy.

In the malleable area, we built towers using shaving foam.

We acted out the story "The 3 Billy Goats Gruff", using puppets.

We will talk about Poppy Day and make our own poppies as well as painted poppies, we did salt painting and we also made kites.

Next Week in Caterpillars Class

In the role play area we will have a Post Office, we will make our own party invitations, writing letters in literacy. We will be measuring out different dry foods and comparing their weights for Maths, we will be making smoothies. And we will practise counting beyond 10 to 20.

This week in Ladybirds Class.....

We painted using rollers as well as our fingers for expressive arts and design.

For Literacy this week we acted out "The Tiger Who Came to Tea", taking turns to be the tiger as well as acting out "The 3 Little Pigs" in the sand tray.

We did some poppy painting and made paper poppies.

We sang number songs and practised counting from 1 to 5, we worked on counting out 5 objects and we have been learning the names of colours.

We worked on our fine motor skills, using tweezers.

We worked on taking turns when playing the game "What's in the bag?"

We listened to the sounds that different musical instruments make and trying to name the instruments.

Next Week in Ladybird's Class

We will be naming real food in the kitchen role play area. We will have a hairdresser's in the role play area for half the week and then a doctor's surgery for the rest of the week. We will continue to work on number recognition and we will continue to work on our fine motor skills - threading.
