This week in Caterpillars Class

We had a shark theme to some of our learning this week, in Mathematics we used a measuring tape outside to see how long different sharks were, recognising the numbers on the tape measure. For Literacy we played with the shark letters game, we had to feed the shark the correct letter and sound.

We practised our fine motor skills when chopping fruit to make smoothies, we used raspberries, bananas, apple and lime juice, the smoothies were very tasty. We also used pegs to hang up baby clothes on the washing line, this helped us practise our pincer grip.

In our role play area this week, we had Caterpillars Post Office and Caterpillars Shiny Teeth dentist. We used the 'Drill and Fill' dentist Playdoh and talked about how to look after our teeth.

Our Christmas songs are being practised every day, ready for our Christmas sing-a-long, we are getting really good with the actions.

In our role play area next week we will have Caterpillars Baby Clinic, we will be weighing and measuring the babies, looking after them and changing their nappies.

We will be talking about our daily routines using prepositions, before, next after.

For Mathematics we will be looking at Clocks, recognising the numbers and beginning to talk about time.
